Lingotto e OGR

Know to preserve. Tools for the regeneration project [*"Conoscere per conservare. Strumenti per il progetto di rigenerazione"*], MANUEL FERNANDO RAMELLO, AIPAI

Dr. Ramello, architect and industrial archaeologist, on behalf of AIPAI – Associazione Italiana per il Patrimonio Archeologico Industriale, presented and discussed: the case study of Lingotto area, a paradigmatic urban requalification intervention in post-Fordist Turin. A new portion of the city is created starting from the FIAT factory, with the aim of design a new urban perspective; the cases study of OGR, Officina Grandi Riparazioni, Turin, which from being a site for large-scale train repairs has now become one of the most interesting poles on the national scene for art and creative industrie.

Consorzio Factory Grisù

Regeneration Practices: The Grisù Consortium Factory in the Giardino Neighbourhood

The former fire station, headquarters of the Consorzio Factory Grisù, was inaugurated in 1930 and definitively abandoned in 2004. In August 2012 the property was granted by the Province of Ferrara on a free loan to the Grisù non-profit association, managed it until February 2016. From this first experience, the Consorzio Factory Grisù was born, made up of 20 creative cultural companies. Established in Ferrara in February 2016, the Consorzio Factory Grisù is today the manager of the property with a contract (loan for use) expiring in 2027.

Porto Fluviale REC Houses

Transurbances: Losing Oneself as Urban Regeneration

FRANCESCO CARERI, Stalker / Osservatorio Nomade / Università Roma Tre

Prof. Careri presented for the first time the PNRR interdisciplinary and intersectoral case study of Porto Fluviale Rechouse. An urban regeneration project for the redevelopment of illegally occupied premises in Via del Porto Fluviale, Rome. The project foresees both the philological and social redevelopment of the building, with the creation of new social housing. In July 2021 the project received funding from the Ministry of Infrastructures and Sustainable Mobility (MIMS) with 11 million from the Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR).
